## **The Cleveland Museum of Art's NEO Exhibit Features Gallery Talks from NEO's Artists**

*Video Presentation Receives Best of Show Award  
Three NEO Pieces will be Added to the Museum's Permanent Collection*

**CLEVELAND (July 6, 2005)** — The Cleveland Museum of Art (CMA) is pleased to feature the 2005 Northeast Ohio (NEO) regional art exhibition. Nearly 1,300 Northeast Ohio artists entered works of art into the juried show and following a three-stage screening process, were narrowed down to 80 works. The NEO exhibition of 80 regional artists' works, including three new installments to the Museum's permanent collection, as well as four works that have been awarded prizes provided by Dominion, will be on view at the Museum **July 10 through Sept. 4, 2005.
